Summer Book Report Grade 4

It is very important that you continue to read all summer. Your summer reading assignment is to read at least **four** books by the authors on the attached reading list. Of course, you may read as many additional books as wish. Keep a record of the books you read on the attached Summer Reading Log. Under "Comments" on the log you can say whether you liked the book or not.

For one book you read you must write a book report. Reports should be in complete sentences and paragraphs. They may be typed or neatly hand written. Always remember to underline the title and to indent paragraphs. The format is as follows:

- Introduction: Opening paragraph should include the title, author, and classification (mystery, fantasy, biography...)
- Body: Paragraphs should include characters, setting, and plot summary.
- Conclusion: Final paragraph should tell your favorite part, whether you liked or disliked the book, and if you would recommend the book to a friend.
- Reports should be 1 page, do not need a picture, and will be collected in early September.

Due Dates:

- Book Log due the 1st day of school
- Book Report will be due in September (exact date will be given once school begins)
